Minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday 26 October 2021, 7.00pm at Leigh & Bransford Memorial Hall

- 2. Declaration of Interests Peter King declared an interest in planning application 21/01785/PIP, stating that he would make comments in the closed section of the meeting and withdraw when the item was discussed

Meeting closed for open forum

A representative of the residents of Chapel Lane adjacent to Our Place explained how the site had developed. He gave examples of how the residents are affected by noise, and occasional trespass resulting in the enjoyment of their homes and gardens being affected. The number of staff required is leading to large volumes of traffic. The residents are concerned that there may be applications for further extensions on the site. His comments were supported by another resident. PC members were able to discuss further details of the situation with the residents attending.

The applicant for planning applications 21/01697/OUT, 21/01781/OUT and 21/01808/FUL explained why they had submitted three planning applications for the site and an adjacent field. He also mentioned why they had gone to appeal on the recent planning refusal.

Peter King spoke on the planning application for Instones (21/01785/PIP). He stated he was happy to see the house was not to be demolished and will be eventually occupied again. The PIP application gives very little details of what would be built in the garden of the house and whether it would be 2 or 3 houses. There were no details of the drive that would serve all the properties on the site. The sizes of the proposed buildings are not specified and there is a fear that the site may be over developed leading to a loss of garden for the properties.

The **meeting re-opened**, and Peter King left the meeting at this point.

- i) Instones may be outside the development boundary for Leigh Sinton but all the house further down Stocks Lane are also outside the boundary as it is set currently and 3 of these houses have been built in the last 10 15 years. Instones existed before the boundary was set as did some of the houses in Stocks Lane. Therefore, the boundary is not valid and is due to be revised to include all of Stocks Lane houses.
- ii) The proposed development sits outside the current and proposed development boundary.
- iii) The following condition to be associated: All Porta-Cabins to be removed from site once the development is completed.

- iv) The application, especially in respect of the single storey extension, is not in accordance with SWDP Policy 21.A or 21.B.x. There are also possible issues relating to the overall impact of the development on nearby designated assets in the same row of dwellings.
